Missions Partner: Camp Duncan in Aberdeen, NC

Partner Description – Camp Duncan is a newly developed therapeutic wilderness camp for troubled girls ages of 10-16. A foundation established by the late Haskell Duncan has opened the door for Camp Duncan to make a dream into a reality. Camp Duncan is part of the Baptist Children’s Home of NC (BCH) and a member of the Wilderness Road Therapeutic Camping Association (WRTCA). Wilderness therapeutic camping has been an effective alternative to state-run correctional facilities for decades. ‘Campers’ attending Camp Duncan will have an average stay of 14 months. During that time the girls will learn life lessons, remain up to speed on schooling, work through their problems and come face to face with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Camper’s families also receive counseling in order to nurture the environment that the child will return to once they leave camp.

Paul Daley, long time director of Cameron Boys Camp (also part of the BCH and WRTCA), recently ventured out to start Camp Duncan. Along with other staff and countless volunteers he has been forming Camp from the ground up. Camp is set to open its doors to serve girls and their families in early September 2010!

Mission Description: Our time spent at Camp Duncan will be focused around building an outdoor chapel where the girls will come understand and grow in their relationship with Jesus. The chapel will be used at least twice a week by campers and will provide a stunning outdoor sanctuary for worship and learning. Our work will meet a need that will serve these girls for years to come!

Purpose: During our trip we will look for ways to serve Camp Duncan. We will also focus on understanding our mission as followers of Jesus Christ. So often we think of missions as something that is done “over there” in another city or country. But when we look at what Christ desires, we will find that he sees missions as something that starts *at home* with our family and friends. This will be a time to go and meet a need but will also be a time to get away and prepare for the mission we have here.
